Why so many tests?

Parents may ask, "Why are there so many required tests?" Students may ask, "Do we get a grade for this?" These are questions many of us have asked at one point or another. Well the answer is simple. The students' performance on these tests provide an idea of what students already know, and what they need help to understand. Teachers use this information to create purposeful lesson plans. Principals use this information to plan for and monitor student achievement at the school. The District uses this information to make decisions about the use of funds and resources. These scores are also reported to the Alabama State Department of Education. They use the scores to monitor progress from year-to-year and to assign a "Report Card" score.
