K-3 Reading Assessment Plan Senate Bill 681 Requirements

All K-3 students must take the state-approved reading assessments beginning in the 2024-25 school year. A Kindergarten Entry Assessment (KEA) (DRDP-K Essential) must be given the first two -six weeks of school by the classroom teacher. The kindergarten reading assessment must be administered before November 15th or within the first 30 days of the school year. Grades 1-3 reading assessments must be administered within the first 30 days of the school year and within the last 30 days of the school year. Any newly-enrolled students in grades 1-5 must be assessed within the first 30 days of entering the district using a state-approved reading assessment to determine the level of reading or reading readiness. All students assigned a Reading Success Plan (RSP) and who have not exited the plan before the end of grade 3 must complete a beginning-and end-of-year assessment through grade 5 or until they exit their RSP, whichever comes first. These assessments must be administered within the first 30 days of the school year and within the last 30 days of the school year.

All of the following assessments are from the Renaissance state approved literacy tests.

Kindergarten Assessments: These assessments need to be completed during the first 30 days of school or no later than November 15th.
