President Dave Kraenzel called the meeting to order. Holly Martinson was absent. All other members were present. There was one guest/s.

William McCone moved to approve the agenda. Jason Krizan seconded. MCU.

William McCone moved to approve the minutes as presented. Justin Wehri seconded. MCU.

Ashlie Palmer moved to approve the April General, Lunch and Activity Fund Bills. Jason Krizan seconded. MCU.

President Dave Kraenzel read a resignation from David Ling resigning his bus driver position at the end of the school year. He also read a resignation from Odin Norum resigning his 7-12 science teaching position at the end of the school year.

Superintendent Mr. Schaff gave his athletic director's report. He stated the co-op with Richardton-Taylor Public School was approved.
