The September 17, 2021 special meeting, which was called for the purpose of holding a student expulsion hearing, was held virtually by way of Zoom at the request of the parents and their attorney. At the September 17 meeting, Attorney McKeon, serving as the hearing officer on behalf of the New Milford Board of Education, took the following actions.

Attorney McKeon called the hearing to order at 12:01 p.m. and immediately moved the hearing into executive session as personally identifiable information relating to the student who was the subject of the hearing was likely to be discussed.


Attorney McKeon returned the hearing to public session at 12:09 p.m., at which time he took the following actions:

The hearing officer moved on behalf of the New Milford Board of Education that the Factual Findings and Legal Conclusions set forth in the parties' Stipulated Expulsion Agreement and that were discussed in Executive Session regarding the student who is the subject of this hearing be adopted by the Board.

The hearing officer further moved on behalf of the Board that based upon such factual findings and legal conclusions, the parties' Stipulated Expulsion Agreement be adopted in total as the Board's decision and that a letter be sent to both parties reiterating this decision.

At 12:11, Attorney McKeon adjourned the meeting.
