Manuscript B, 2V-3V (Part I)

Seeing myself so tenderly loved, I dared to pronounce these words: "O Mother! I beg you, tell me whether God will leave me for a long time on earth. Will He come soon to get me?" Smiling tenderly, the saint whispered: "Yes, soon, soon, I promise you." I added: "Mother, tell me further if God is not asking something more of me than my poor little actions and desires. Is He content with me?" The saint's face took on an expression incomparably more tender than the first time she spoke to me. Her look and her caresses were the sweetest of answers. However, she said to me: "God asks no other thing from you. He is content, very content!" After again embracing me with more love than the tenderest of mothers has ever given to her child, I saw her leave. My heart was filled with joy, and then I remembered my Sisters, and I wanted to ask her some favors for them, but alas, I awoke!

O Jesus, the storm was no longer raging, Heaven was calm and serene. I believed, I felt, there was a Heaven and that this Heaven is peopled with souls who actually love me, who consider me their child. **This**

impression remains in my heart, and this all the more because I was, up until then, absolutely indifferent to Venerable Mother Anne of Jesus. I never invoked her in prayer and the thought of her never came to my mind except when I heard others speak of her, which was seldom. And when I understood to what a degree she loved me, how indifferent I had been toward her, my heart was filled with love and gratitude, not only for the Saint who had visited me but for all the blessed inhabitants of Heaven.

O my Beloved! This grace was only the prelude to the greatest graces You wished to bestow upon me. Allow me, my only Love, to recall them to You today, today which is the sixth anniversary of our union. Ah! my Jesus, pardon me if I am unreasonable in wishing to express my desires and longings which reach even unto infinity. Pardon me and heal my soul by giving her what she longs for so much!

To be Your Spouse, to be a Carmelite, and by my union with You to be the Mother of souls, should not this suffice me? And yet, it is not so. No doubt, these three privileges sum up my true vocation: Carmelite, Spouse, Mother, and yet I feel within me other vocations. I feel the vocation of THE WARRIOR, THE PRIEST, THE APOSTLE, THE DOCTOR, THE MARTYR. Finally, I feel the need and the desire of carrying out the most heroic deeds for You, O Jesus. I feel within my soul the courage of the Crusader, the Papal Guard, and I would want to die on the field of battle in defense of the Church.

I feel in me the vocation of the PRIEST. With what love, O Jesus, I would carry You in my hands when, at my voice, You would come down from Heaven. And with what love would I give You to souls! But alas! while desiring to be a Priest, I admire and envy the humility of St. Francis of Assisi and I feel the vocation of imitating him in refusing the sublime dignity of the Priesthood.

Novena with Fr. Donald Kinney, OCD



During this 100th anniversary year of our Parish, the Novena to St. Therese (**September 22-30**) and her feast day on October 1 will be especially joyful. We have invited Fr. Donald Kinney, OCD, to offer the Mass and preach each evening. He owes his vocation to St. Therese. He was ordained here on October 1, 1988. Fr. Donald is now assigned at the Carmelite House of Prayer in Oakville, in the Napa Valley.

Also during the Novena, Fr. Donald will be promoting the visit of the reliquary of St. Therese. It will be coming to Alhambra and our Parish from October 11 to 13, 2025. The year 2025 is also the 100th anniversary of the Canonization of St. Therese and a Jubilee Year in the entire Church.

On Saturdays and Sundays (September 22, 28, and 29), the Novena Mass will be at 5:00 p.m. On the weekdays, the Mass will be at 7:15 p.m. During this Novena, the Tuesday evening Mass will be in English. On October 1, the Feast of St. Therese, the Mass will be at 7:15 p.m.

The "Mystery of the Church"

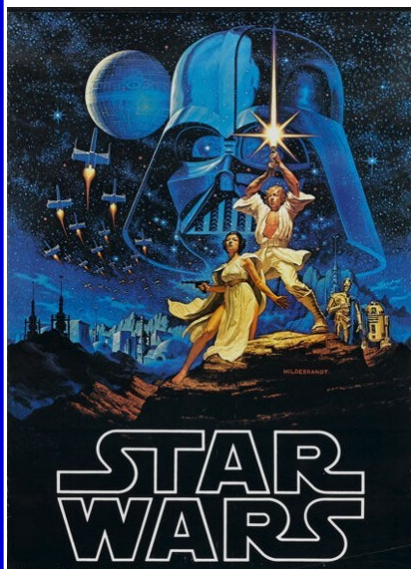
Fr. Stephen Watson, OCD, invites everyone to attend a new series of classes he will conduct on the *Mystery of the Church*. These lectures will also serve as a catechetical mystagogy for the newly baptized. Mystagogy is a term that comes from the Greek word meaning, "to lead through the mysteries." The Catechism describes mystagogy as a "liturgical catechesis that aims to initiate people into the mystery of Christ" (CCC 1075). Mystagogy is the form of catechesis that expounds on the spiritual treasures contained in the sacraments. St. Augustine refers to the Church as the "wondrous sacrament born from Christ's side."



The Acts of the Apostles will serve as a primary reference for these classes. Fr. Stephen will also lead the class in a close reading of *Lumen Gentium*, which is the dogmatic constitution on the Church of the Second Vatican Council (Vatican II). The hymn, *The Church's One Foundation*, embodies the theme and content of these classes.

These lectures will begin with two classes—on **Tuesday, September 17, and Wednesday, September 18, from 7:30 to 9:00 p.m.** The first two classes are back-to-back due to the novena taking place on all the other evenings in September. Thereafter, they will take place twice a month on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month.

UNDERSTANDING LOVE:

Following the lead of the Holy Spirit.

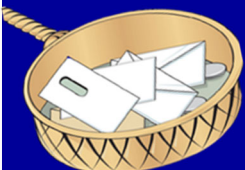
Christianity is not when we join a Church, accept Jesus, or are baptized (Acts 8:9-24). It is when Christ dwells in us (Romans 8:9b,14). It is Christ in us through the Holy Spirit that changes us from our human insanity to God's sane way of being (Hebrews 13:20-21). Christians are transformed through following the lead of the Holy Spirit.

We are led by the Holy Spirit the same way we are led by the human spirit (I Corinthians 2:11). We "hear" the voice of the human spirit; now we "hear" the voice of the Holy Spirit. We do not see the beauty of God's perfect, selfless holiness when we view Him through our false presuppositions about goodness and love (Isaiah 55:8-9, 25:7). As we think, feel, and act more like God, the Holy Spirit bridges the chasm between God and man. Without the Holy Spirit we are hostile and think this way is insane (Romans 8:7). With the Holy Spirit, the veil is removed, and we are transformed (II Corinthians 3:16-18). This is the effect of grace.

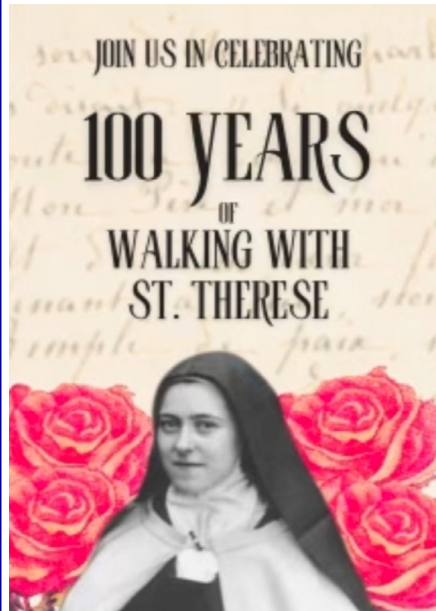

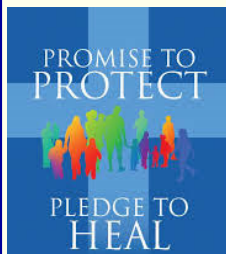

"LET ME INTRODUCE YOU..." By Fr. Stephen F. Watson OCD

Last year, as I was walking by the Parish Hall, I saw a lot of boys and girls dressed for karate; at least, that is what we used to call it. It was something I had never seen at a Parish. Mr. Carlos Ibarra, a St. Therese School teacher, was conducting an after-school martial arts class, which he still teaches in our Parish Hall. It is open to all boys and girls, not just Parish schoolchildren. I sat down with Carlos last week at one of the tables where the children have lunch and interviewed him for the bulletin. This is the story of the **Carlos and Rosalinda Ibarra Family**.

Carlos Alberto Ibarra, Jr., is the son of two immigrant parents: Carlos Ibarra, Sr., from El Salvador, and Elia Ibarra from Mexico. Carlos was born in Los Angeles in 1978 and grew up in East LA. Although the family was living in Pico Rivera, Carlos would commute to East LA most of his youth to be taken care of by his grandparents while his mother worked in downtown Los Angeles. Consequently, he also went to the public schools in East LA. After a couple of years at Rio Hondo Community College, Carlos went to Cal State University, where he received his BA in music. That is where he met his future wife, Rosalinda Bao Tram Nguyen, who



was also a music major. Carlos specialized in classical guitar and Rosalinda, in voice. Both also received teaching credentials. As students, they had the opportunity to travel to China, Mexico, Spain, Denmark, and Sweden.

Rosalinda is also the daughter of immigrants: Nga Nguyen and Yen Tran. Her parents moved to California during the United States evacuation of Vietnam. Rosalinda's mom worked as a teacher for the U.S. Embassy, so the family was fortunate to be airlifted out of Vietnam. Rosalinda was born in California, and her family eventually settled in Alhambra. Rosalinda is a graduate of Alhambra High School.

Although Rosalinda was baptized as a child, she did not receive the other Sacraments of Initiation. In 2007, after completing the RCIA classes at San Gabriel Mission, Rosalinda was fully initiated into the Catholic faith by receiving Confirmation and making her First Holy Communion. The next year, Carlos and Rosalinda were married at San Gabriel Mission. For the next couple of years, they served as music ministers at the Mission's 11:15 Mass and were involved with *Families for Life Ministries*.

Carlos and Rosalinda went to work as music teachers. Carlos worked at Little Lake City School District and Rosalinda, for Long Beach School District. After a couple of years, Carlos got a job at Arts in Action Community Charter School. After much prayer, Carlos and Rosalinda decided that Rosalinda would stop teaching so she could spend more time at home and at church. They began to attend St. Peter Chanel Church in Hawaiian Gardens, which is where they were living at the time. There they taught confirmation classes to teenagers and were involved in music ministry during the summer. They also made pilgrimages organized by our parishioners Albert and Mary Helen Estrada to Israel, Italy, and to EWTN in Alabama. Carlos and Rosalinda also attended the eight-day silent retreats at Sacred Heart Retreat House in Alhambra. They made numerous retreats and often attended Catholic conferences.

In 2018 Carlos and Rosalinda welcomed their miracle baby boy, Yosef-Mari. Rosalinda had several miscarriages before then, so having a child was an amazing feeling for her. When Covid hit, the Ibarras began attending Holy Innocents Church in Long Beach. Due to Covid politics, Carlos lost his teaching job at Arts in Action, but he was able to work as a substitute teacher at both Holy Innocents School and Saint Therese Carmelite School, where he was introduced to classical education. In March of 2022, he was hired full-time at our School as the 5th and 6th grade teacher. He also teaches guitar and, as mentioned above, martial arts. In addition, he is one of the leaders of the Troops of St. George, which has proven to be popular here at St. Therese. Carlos also helps Fr. Robert to train altar servers. Rosalinda is active in the School as well, having volunteered as the 1st-grade choir teacher and as a substitute teacher for 1st and 2nd grades. She also has helped with the Little Flower/Little Women group for girls.

The Ibarra family now lives close to St. Therese on North Chapel Avenue near Story Park. In a short time, Carlos and Rosalinda have made a big contribution of their time and talent to St. Therese Parish and School. We hope we will see Yosef-Mari make his First Holy Communion here in the next couple of years—and even his Confirmation! We are happy to welcome the Ibarra family to St. Therese.

The Ibarra Family is part of the rich 100-year history of St. Therese Parish.
Let us all walk with St. Therese as we journey together in faith during our Centennial year.
