SECONDARY DRESS CODE

Ridgeview Global Studies Academy has a mandatory dress code for all secondary students. There are many positive reasons for a school dress code, including:

- A dress code puts the focus on academics, nor fashion, because students project a neat, serious, businesslike image.
- Schools with dress codes have fewer discipline problems because students aren't distracted.
- Dress codes can reduce expenses for families.
- Dress codes eliminate the visible differences between needy and wealthy children.
- Dress codes eliminate pressure to wear brand-name clothing, "gang colors," etc.
- Dress codes create a sense of school pride and belonging.

BOTTOMS: Navy, black, khaki/tan, or jeans

- shorts (mid-thigh), pants, skorts, skirts, skirted jumpers, sweat pants (black and grey only)
- must be plain, solid-color twill or jean material (navy, black, khaki/tan)
- jeans (denim only) will be allowed as long as they do not have holes, tears, or frays
- MUST BE APPROPRIATE SIZE (LENGTH AND TIGHTNESS)

TOPS:

- must be purchased from school (RGSA embroidered logo)
- Grades 6-8: Athletic Heather, Jet Black, or Royal Blue polo with collar
- Grades 9-12: Navy, Dark Grey, or Light Blue polo with collar
- Fridays only: school purchased RGSA spirit shirts or RGSA club/sports shirts may be worn in place of the uniform top.

JACKETS AND/OR SWEATSHIRTS:

- during cold weather, students may layer long sleeve shirts UNDER their official RGSA polo shirts. Long sleeve shirts must be solid neutral colors.
- **NEW** hoodie option available for sale through RGSA office!
- official RGSA jackets, hoodies and sweatshirts are the only jackets, hoodies, or sweatshirts to be worn.
- official RGSA jackets, hoodies, and sweatshirts are available for sale or order through the school office.

OTHER DRESS CODE RULES:

- clothes must be appropriate size and worn at the student's waist at all times
- shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer
- shoes must be safe, appropriate, and have enclosed heels or a heel strap (flip flops, slides and sandals without heel straps may not be worn)
- clothing that is too tight or too loose is not appropriate for school

NOT ALLOWED: clothing with colored trim, stripes, embroidery, decorations, overalls (pants or shorts), leggings, gym shorts, hats/caps, etc.

DRESS CODE CONSIDERED UNSAFE:

- Spiked Projections from rings, belts, belt buckles, or any item worn by the student (Spiked items will be confiscated and not returned to the student.)
- Safety pins
- Apparel with emblems, printing, etc., that creates animosity between groups and/or individuals
- Metal reinforced footwear (Steel toe)
- Earrings, jewelry, body piercing or accessories which present a safety hazard to the wearer or others are not suitable for school
- Pictures of weapons
- Bandanas, dew rags, wave caps
- Wallet Chains or chains with links (these items will be confiscated and returned to the parents)
- No fishnet hosiery

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS WILL DETERMINE IF CLOTHING IS APPROPRIATE FOR SCHOOL AND COMPLIES WITH RGSA RULES.
