	Petroleum jelly for skin irritation
	Cough drops / throat lozenges as per package direction
	Benadryl 25 mg. Every 4-6 hours for allergic reaction; not to exceed 50 mg.
	Insect repellent with DEET (applied prior to outdoor activities where insects may be present).
	Ibuprofen 200 mg 1-2 tabs every 4-6 hours for headache, pain relief or fever
	Children's Ibuprofen oral suspension 100mg per 5 ml as directed for weight and age for headache, pain relief, fever
	Tylenol 325 mg 1-2 tabs every 4-6 hour for headache, pain relief or fever
	Children's Tylenol / Mapap liquid 160 mg per 5 ml as directed for weight and age for headache, pain relief or fever.
	Tums 1-2 tablets for indigestion
	Visine eye drops in the affected eye every 4-6 hours as needed for minor irritation.
	Instant Hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol when soap and water are not available per CDC & MDPH guidance.
