ECBOE Anaphylaxis Parent Packet Parent/Guardian Instructions and Responsibilities

A. Authorization for Treatment

Written medical authorization is required for any anaphylaxis medication needed for a student in the school setting. Parent/Guardian must submit all the required documents directly to the School Nurse.

B. Required Documents

- 1) Alabama Department of Education School Medication Prescriber/Parent Authorization (PPA) form.
 - A separate PPA form must be submitted for each medication order.
 - Each PPA must be authorized by Parent/Guardian and Medical Provider.
- 2) Medical Statement for Students Requiring Special Meals and/or Accommodation form.
 - Must include Diet accommodations and be signed by Parent/Guardian and Medical Provider.

AND/OR

• Must include a Child Nutrition Program Food Substitution/Religious Statement.

3) Individual Healthcare Plan (IHP) and/or Emergency Action Plan (EAP).

- The Parent/Guardian should review with the School Nurse to develop and authorize his/her student's detailed plan of care.
- 4) Alabama State Department of Education Health Assessment Record (HAR) form.
 - The Parent/Guardian must complete, thru online registration, indicating specific health related needs of their student/s.

C. Medication

All medication must be in Pharmacy labeled container or in a sealed original over the counter container in compliance with *Medication Administration Guidelines* (see ECBOE website under *Health Services*).
