

#### **Notes from the Principal**

- ❖ A quick reminder about morning drop off and pick up. In the morning if you are getting out of your car to assist your children, please pull up toward the playground to unload. Please keep pulling up close to the cars in front of you. We ask that you do not drop off children across the street or in the middle of the street. In the afternoon, please use the four lanes and be tight to the car in front of you. At both times we ask for your patience and cooperation as dismissal takes about ten minutes.
- ❖ Our first marking period closed yesterday. Our report cards will be finalized and sent out on Tuesday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> at 11:30 a.m. You can view the report cards on Option C, no paper copies are given out. Remember parents can go on Option C anytime to view your child's current grades.

- ❖ Good luck to all of our Winter Sports teams as they prepare to begin their seasons representing St. Anne against other teams. #### NEW SCHOOL/PARISH VOLUNTEER CLEARANCE REQUIRED

IMPORTANT ... PLEASE READ.....ACTION REQUIRED!

Hello School Volunteers,

Thank you to so many parents who have obtained their REQUIRED ST. ANNE SCHOOL/PA STATE and DIOCESAN Clearances. It is all about following the law and keeping our children safe!! *There are no exceptions* – to engage in school sponsored events involving children, everyone must obtain ALL required clearances.

\*\*\*\*\*The National Sex Offender Registry Clearance is the newest volunteer clearance to be officially requested/required by the Diocese of Allentown. It is on the list of requirements for clearances. Please see the attached form:

- 1. Fill out the form completely it is just a few lines
- 2. Email it to the address listed on the form
- 3. You will receive the clearance by email and it will be mailed to your home in about 10 days...
- 4. PLEASE FORWARD a copy of the NSOR clearance and a copy of the completed application to my attention You can email it, or, send it to the school main office in an envelope marked: Attn: Eileen Brida.

\*\*\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE: You may continue to volunteer for the present, while acquiring this clearance.

The following individuals must complete the National Sex Offender Registry verification application:	
<ul> <li>Any individual 18 years or older residing in the child care setting where child care is occurring.</li> <li>Any individual working for a Regulated Child Care Provider.</li> <li>Any individual with an ownership interest (corporate or non-corporate) in a Regulated Child Care Provider and who participates in the organization and management of the operation.</li> <li>Any volunteer of a child care provider, group day-care home or family child care home.</li> </ul>	
Type or print clearly in Ink. Fill in all necessary fields on the application. Once completed, use one of the following three options to submit the application for processing:	
<ol> <li>Mail to the Clearance Verification Unit, ChildLine at the following address: Department of Human Services PO Box 8170 Harrisburg, PA 17105-8170; OR</li> </ol>	
<ol> <li>Scan the completed application and small to: <u>RA-PWNSOR@pa.gov</u> in the subject line list 'NSOR Verification Applicant Last Name (i.e., Smith); OR</li> </ol>	
<ol> <li>Hand deliver to the Clearance Verification Unit drop off box located at: 2525 North 7th Street, Harrieburg, PA 17110. Free parking is available in the visitor's lot at front of the building.</li> </ol>	
<ul> <li>Processing time is fourteen days from the date the application is received.</li> <li>Retain a copy of the completed application for your record. You may need a copy as proof of your submission for your employer.</li> <li>There is no fee for the National Sex Offender Registry verification letter.</li> <li>Refer all questions to the Clearance Verification Unit at 877-371-5422.</li> </ul>


