Dear Parishioners,

Happy Fourth Sunday of Advent. While a shorter week, as Christmas is on Wednesday this year, it can be one of deep impact, as we more intensely prepare for the Lord's return, and prepare to celebrate His birth.

Don't rush too quickly to Christmas, and don't rush Christmas away! Remember that Christmas is a season, which ends with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord celebrated January 12 this year. In fact, I again remind you that the Twelve Days of Christmas begin on Christmas Day and are celebrated through January 6, the traditional day of the Feast of Epiphany (moved in the US to the Sunday between January 1 and January 13).

While the culture celebrates a secularized Christmas, one filled with gifts, food, and warm wishes, we celebrate by remembering we received the most precious gifts of life, redemption, and salvation because of the One born for us. We eat perhaps a little more richly, calling to mind the feast to which our Savior's birth begins to invite us. And we spread the joy of this good news, a message loaded with content and excitement. Celebrate well!

The Church offers four different sets of prayer and readings (Christmas Eve, Christmas Midnight, Mass at Dawn, and Christmas Day). I will use the proper prayers and readings in order (so the 4:30 pm Christmas Eve Mass at St. Eloi will have the Christmas Eve Mass with the genealogy of Jesus, the 10:00 pm Mass at St. Edward will use the Mass at Midnight with the birth of Jesus, the 8:30 am Mass at St. Edward will use the worship of the Shepherds, and the 10:30 am Mass at St. Eloi will use the Prologue of St. John's Gospel.

These particular gospels are all part of the Christmas story, each their own way, and using all four throughout our celebration helps flesh out the Incarnation a little more fully. Of course, I encourage you to read the Nativity story as family whether it is used at the Mass you attend or not – it is Luke 2. With that, while still early, I wish all of you and your family a merry Christmas!

All of our actions, sacrifices, and prayers ought to prepare us for that hour on Sunday when we encounter our Lord. Conversely, the Mass and Holy Communion ought to vitalize all of the actions, work, and prayers of the coming week. Let us learn to see the Lord's Day, and especially Sunday Mass, as the most important event of the week by directing our actions to this moment.

Let us pray.

Lord, by your Cross you have redeemed the world. Dispel the fear of suffering from our hearts and give us the hope and detachment necessary to allow you to guide us to mature manhood in your image. We ask this in your most holy name. Amen.
