Materials

Grades

Homework will be used to reward those students who complete such assignments by improving their overall grade through a point system to be determined. Although strongly recommended for completion to assist in student comprehension, non-completion of homework will not negatively affect a student's grade. The instructor understands that due to varied life responsibilities outside of school, homework may not be able to be completed each time it is assigned.

- Nine weeks grades will be formulated as follows:
  - 70% - Major Exams
  - 30% - Quizzes/Classwork
  - Note: For the last several years, End of Course (EOC) exams have not been a part of a student's final grade. However, this could change depending on decisions made beyond the local level. Once information is confirmed as to the inclusion or exclusion of the EOC, the instructor will inform the students.
- Student grades will be viewable by parents through Skyward. Grades will be updated weekly to ensure that parents are aware of their child's progress.

### Absences

Students are responsible for making up major exams and quizzes in this course. Students should consult their instructor to schedule a time in order to complete any missed major exams or quizzes. Students and parents should refer to Google Classroom in order to identify coursework covered during an absence.
