

**KINNALLY-ACP SCHOLARSHIP
APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Please Note: Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Screenshots of the application are not accepted. In addition to the completed and signed application form, all students applying for a scholarship must submit the following materials:

1. Scholarship application with Student Essay
2. Official transcript or report card, displaying GPA if calculated by current school.
3. Two Letters of Recommendation
4. Parent Information Form
5. Apply for tuition assistance through the FACTS system to determine financial need
6. Provide proof of TEFA application

1. Student Essay Questions

The student essay should speak to the following:

- a. How will a Catholic education prepare you for future endeavors?
- b. What are your goals both in high school and after graduation?
- c. Talk about your past and present extracurricular activities whether they are school-related, church-related or related to the broader San Antonio community. What have you learned from those experiences?
- d. Choose a person you admire and explain why.

2. Grade Point Average Documentation

Submit a current official transcript or final report card showing a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher or its equivalent in the absence of a calculated GPA.

3. Letters of Recommendation

Submit two letters of recommendation. The letters cannot be from family members. We recommend asking a teacher, coach, employer, volunteer supervisor or pastor/clergy.

Recommendation letters must address the following questions:

- How long have you known the student and in what capacity?
- How will the student benefit from this opportunity?
- What are the student's strengths?
- What skills does the student possess that will benefit him or her in private, faith-based setting?
- Speak to the student's work ethic, loyalty, honesty, and compassion for others.

4. Parent Information Form

The parent or legal guardian must complete the Parent Information Form.

5. Household Income Verification

Verification of financial need will be reported to the scholarship committee by Antonian as determined through the FACTS application process.

6. TEFA Application Verification

The students must have applied for the Texas Education Freedom Account (TEFA) and show proof of application. Any student is eligible to receive the Kinnally-ACP scholarship whether they received TEFA funding or not; only proof of application is required.

Submission Instructions

Application materials must be emailed as attachments to **Mark Papich at ACP (mpapich@antonian.org)** by 5:00 pm, June 30, 2026. Students are encouraged to submit their application early to avoid any delays in receipt of the scholarship documents. Applicants will be notified of award decisions by July 15, 2026.
