## SMA Belles Are Women of Distinction

### Red Ties Recognized for National Merit Scholarship

In October 2014, Red Tie sisters **Alexandrea and Angelica Chima '15** each received *Letters of Commendation* from the National Merit Scholarship Corporation in recognition of their outstanding academic promise. This prestigious honor is granted to only students who score in the top 3% nationally after taking the PSAT/NMSQT as juniors. Alex and Angelica are among the top 50,000 out of 1.5 million entrants who took the test in fall of 2013. Although Commended Students do not continue in the competition for National Merit Scholarships, many become candidates for a wide variety of special scholarships sponsored by corporations, businesses, and universities.

Red Tie **Drew WP '15** has also received recognition for her PSAT score. The National Achievement Scholarship Program has named her an Outstanding Participant among Black American high school students for 2015. Drew is among the top 4,700 of the over 160,000 students who entered the National Achievement Program in fall of 2013. Although Outstanding Participants do not continue in the competition for Achievement Scholarships, their names are referred to about 1,500 four-year colleges and universities for appropriate consideration during the admissions process.

**Norene Murray Zapanta '65**, current Chair-Elect of the SMA Board of Directors, gave the keynote address at the "Celebrating Our Partnership" Appreciation Dinner:

One week after my freshman year at St. Mary's, my father died suddenly—I was the oldest of 3 children. My mother made an appointment to meet with Sr. Mary Ann who was the treasurer at St. Mary's. My mother and I were very anxious about that meting. Sr. Mary Ann turned out to be a delightful person. After that meeting, I was on financial aid, and that certainly began a new and different partnership [for me] with St. Mary's and the CSI's. The Sisters had now agreed to help me with 1/4 of my tuition for the next three years. That was a generous commitmnt they made for my future.

After my husband's death in 2002, I realized I needed to make more of a difference somewhere and somehow. I knew I owed so much to SMA and so I reconnected... I was asked to serve as copresident of our Alumnae Organization. After two years as co-president of the SMA Alumnae Association, I made the decision to ask to serve on the SMA Board of Directors. I was pleased to be accepted and have just begun my fourth year on that Board.

Through my service at SMA, I have realized how very important it is to out live your life. Think about that. How do you out live your life? You need to create a legacy and make a difference that will live on well past your life time.
