1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(e) funded. (2500 character limit).

Our Community School values Arts and Music In Education. Through the additional funding we were able to provide both music and art opportunities to students. In 2022-2023, students in grades TK-6th had music with Bebu music. This program provided students access to a variety of instruments, singing, and performing at student-led assemblies. In the fall of 2023-2024, students in grades TK-6 had music instruction where students were taught music theory, singing and performing. In the late fall of 2023-2024, we hired a credentialed art teacher that was part time. This teacher provided art instruction to students in grades TK-6 until the middle of January. Then in January at the start of our second semester we introduced a Middle School Art Elective for students in grades 7-8 and our art teacher provided art instruction to students in grades 3-6. At the end of January, Bebu music returned and provided music education to students in grades TK-2 and a music elective for students in grades 7 and 8. We also offered a performing arts elective for students in grades 7 and 8. Both middle school electives provided a student ted assembly where the students gave a performance for the other students and parents.
