Dear Parishioners.

I hope that the cleanup efforts from the recent storms continues to go well and safely. It certainly was sudden and destructive. I did not have a chance to get to the basement before the bulk of the damage was done.

Aside from the 4 trees that we lost in the rectory backyard, the room that had been used for TeenTalk had water and the

carpet was completely drenched. I continue to have some leakage in the furnace room and the cellar, but the rest of the basement is dry.

I am thankful for the help in cleanup. The Traens, Myhres, Lalemans, and Mary Kampa cleaned up the trees, and the KCs helped get the furniture and carpet out of the basement and took care of the trees that fell in the cemetery.

As there is no reason to recarpet the basement, I would propose that we arrange for removing the carpet glue. Hopefully we can get it down to cement, and perhaps we can simply paint it with a waterproofing product. As far as the trees, once the stumps are removed, I would recommend some simple landscaping and planting a few fruit trees like plums or pears. A little extra food growing for our lunch program would be good.

This Saturday is the Ordination of Joshua Bot ad Tanner Thooft, as well as Nathan Hansen. I am so pleased to be pastor when they are ordained, having been the initial contact for their discerning to enter the seminary. It is a great thing for our parishes, too, to have not just one but two ordained. I hope that the example of self-gift that soon-to-be Fr. Bot and Fr. Thooft are demonstrating will inspire other young men to discern God's call to the priesthood, and young women and men to discern the religious life.

Because of the uniqueness of having two ordained, we need to adjust next Sunday's schedule. Both Masses of Thanksgiving are open to all, but the only Mass on Sunday in our parishes will be the 9 am Mass.

Traditionally, Tuesday would be celebrated as the feast of the Ascension, however that has been transferred to next Sunday. All the same, there is the laudable tradition of beginning a Novena to the Holy Spirit on Thursday through the feast of Pentecost. There are several places online that have them, and I have posted them to my blog (Frtodd.blogspot.com) for each day. There is also a fantastic website PrayMoreNovenas.com that will email the daily prayer for the novena out. They also have novenas online, and


