WE ARE UPDATING OUR
SSEC COVID PROTOCOLS AS OF MARCH 4, 2022**

- *MASK REQUIREMENT** As of Monday, March 7, 2022 strongly recommended but not required.
- *LUNCH/BREAKFAST** Return to normal lunch/breakfast procedures beginning sometime after March 7th depending on our ability to resupply the necessary supplies, such as plates, cups Etc. Exact date T.B.D.
- *AEROSOLIZING TENTS** These will be removed the week of March 7, 2022
- *GYMNASIUM USE** Use of the full gymnasium as soon as the tents have been removed.
- *GRADUATIONS & OTHER LARGE GATHERINGS** Program graduations & other large gatherings with outside visitors will be permitted in the gym & conference rooms beginning March 7, 2022.
- *FIELD TRIPS** Permitted now. Masking requirements subject to February 25, 2022 updated federal requirements.
- *THERAPY POOL** Reopen for use starting July 5, 2022
- *PLEASE NOTE**

All of the above require no minimum distancing and masks are strongly recommended but not required except where required by local, state or federal regulations or as indicated below:

 - *Masks will still be required in all nursing offices and all medical waiting rooms, as health care practice locations of licensed providers are subject to mask requirements.**
 - *Masks will still be required for all staff and students who are returning to school on day 6 post COVID infection, through day 10 as transmission may still occur.**
 - *IF masks are still required in either Hull or Randolph beyond March 7, 2022 SSEC staff should follow those requirements.**

In addition, masks should be worn around medically fragile individuals. Also, DESE and DPH strongly recommend unvaccinated individuals should continue to wear masks in school settings. As always, any individual who wishes to continue to mask, including those who face higher risk from COVID-19, should be supported in that choice. DESE and DPH continue to strongly urge all eligible individuals to receive the COVID-19 vaccine and booster. Other mitigations include getting vaccinated against COVID and participating in the statewide COVID-19 At-Home-Testing program.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE AN ON-SITE VACCINE CLINIC AT SSEC HINGHAM ON FRIDAY, MARCH, 18TH BEGINNING AT 8AM. THIS IS OPEN TO 1ST, 2ND, AND BOOSTER DOSES. THIS IS OPEN TO ALL SSEC STAFF, STUDENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES. CLICK THE LINK BELOW TO REGISTER
