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## CELL PHONES

I realize the cell phone issue is a touchy subject and no one wants to give up the phone for long periods of time, but we have a minimal amount of time in class during the semester. We need the least number of distractions as possible and let’s face it, cell phones are a HUGE distraction.

There maybe times when you are allowed to have your phone out, BUT YOU WILL NEED TO WAIT FOR TEACHER PERMISSION! Early finishers will have other opportunities to keep busy with classroom activities.

## LATE WORK/MAKE-UP WORK

I will follow the school make-up work policy for my class. For every day you miss you will have up to that many days to complete your work (no more than 5 days). Example: miss 1 day= 1 day to make up work, miss 2 days= 2 days to make up work, etc.

If you fail to turn in work on time, you will receive a deduction of 20 points per day until your grade reaches a zero. A zero will then go into Power School and it will remain there.
