# **Fact Sheet for Schools and College Access Programs**

Free college and financial aid events are available to Minnesota students and families via Zoom! The series, running Tuesday evenings September 27 through October 25, will cover general college and financial aid information, details on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the Minnesota Dream Act for undocumented students, and other ways to pay for college. #### What are the dates, topics and suggested audience?

All sessions are at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday nights and will last approximately 45-60 minutes. Participants can ask questions in the chat. Participants can attend any number of sessions (choose dates during registration). Suggested audience is 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students and their parent(s)/guardian(s).

- October 25: Search for Scholarships | 10-12<sup>th</sup> grade students

- Press Release Template: Share the announcement with local media outlets.
