School and Community

Founded in 2005, Randolph Early College High School (RECHS) is a nontraditional public high school that is part of the North Carolina Cooperative Innovative High Schools program. An AdvanceEd accredited institution, RECHS is located on the campus of Randolph Community College (RCC) and serves students from across Randolph County. Students are selected to attend RECHS based on an application process and typically enter at the beginning of their high school career. RECHS targets first-generation college students. All students take honors level high school courses and community college courses beginning their first year. An average of two college courses is taken each semester throughout their high school career, with the opportunity to earn an Associate's Degree in 4 or 5 years. All RECHS students follow the North Carolina College/University Prep Course of Study and must complete the requirements of a traditional high school in North Carolina and receive dual credit for community college courses, which contribute credits toward their high school diploma. In addition, student involvement in community service is required.
