Curriculum and Academic Goal Planning

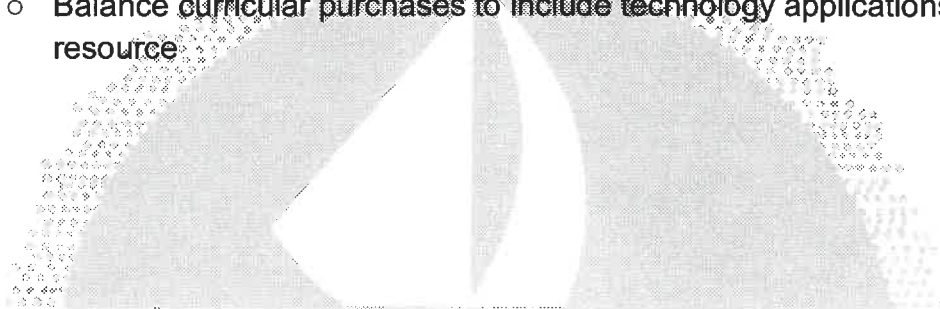
- Curriculum/Academics
