PASTOR'S COLUMN



My Dear Parishioners of St. Therese,

Our Carmelite Saint of the Month is St. Simon Stock (Feast Day, May 16th), who is famous for receiving the Brown Scapular of Our Lady in a vision and for composing the *Flos Carmeli*.

He grew up at a time of great religious enthusiasm. As a young man, he became a hermit in the countryside, fashioning a primitive cell for himself in the hollow of a tree, from which was derived his last name, Stock. This mode of life may seem strange to us, but in that time there were many hermits in the English countryside under the direction of the local Bishop. Eventually, he joined the Carmelite Order, probably after a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. In 1241, he returned to England from Mount Carmel, along with a group of Carmelites sponsored by two English barons. Soon after that, Simon was sent with the original group to make a foundation at Aylesford in Kent.

The era was a turbulent one for the Carmelite Order. Having had to flee Palestine because of persecution and take refuge in Europe, they needed a leader of extraordinary ability. They

elected Simon Stock as their new Prior General. Simon was a man of sanctity and prudence; he loved and respected the traditions of the Order and yet knew how to adapt to their new situation in Europe. He needed to make the Carmelite way of life practicable in a new European society, without changes to the essence of the Rule or detraction from the prophetic vocation. With permission from the Pope for these adaptations, he launched the Order into a new epoch, a golden age for the Carmelites, which would last for a century and a half.

St. Simon Stock was particularly devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He continually pleaded with the Mother of God to grant some privilege to the Order of Carmelites, which enjoys the special title of the Virgin. He prayed devoutly:



**Flower of Carmel, fruitful vine,
Splendor of heaven, Mother divine,
None like to thee;
Mother of meekness, spotless Virgin,
To the Carmelites a favor impart,
Star of the sea.**



St. Simon received the Scapular vision on July 16, 1251. Our Lady appeared to him, holding in her blessed hands the Scapular of the Order. She said **"This shall be a privilege for you and for all Carmelites, that whoever dies clothed in this shall not suffer eternal fire; rather he shall be saved."** The Carmelites had already proposed themselves as an Order particularly devoted to the Blessed Virgin but, now—by Our Lady's promise to St. Simon—those who persevered until their death in loyalty to the Virgin would obtain assistance from her to save their souls. The Scapular was now regarded as a garment of deep religious significance in the Carmelite tradition.

In 1265, while St. Simon was making a visitation to the Carmelite foundation at Bordeaux in France, he took ill and died. His remains were kept in the room in the monastery where he died, and the room was converted into a chapel. Soon there were reports of numerous miracles which took place there. In 1276, the Holy See permitted the celebration of a Mass in his honor by the Carmelites of Bordeaux, which was later extended to the whole Order.



for Adults) Program and was baptized at St. Therese. This became a bit of a theme, as Karen and all three of their children (Nicholas—32, Peter—30, and Michael—28) were also baptized here!

The Owenses initially set up home on Cordova Street in Alhambra. As their family grew, they ended up moving to South Pasadena, but continued to call St. Therese “home.” An educator, Karen spent most of her career teaching at Monterey Hills Elementary School, directly across the street from the Owenses’ house. Rex’s career with the Automobile Club of Southern California (AAA) lasted 30 years; in the course of time, he began managing the company’s commercial real estate holdings across the United States. Rex joked that every day he would make the 42-mile commute to his office in Costa Mesa, while Karen would make the 42-step commute to her classroom.

The family has always enjoyed travel. Feeding Karen’s passion for American history while at the same time educating their boys, the Owenses made regular trips to visit (and re-visit) historic locations from the Revolutionary and Civil Wars. They also enjoy taking family cruises, having visited Europe and Alaska. To this day, Rex and Karen consider London their “happy place,” always using it as a stopping off point for their European travels. With the boys grown, family travel is more difficult; the Owenses’ oldest son, Nicholas, is an Orange County Sheriff’s deputy and was just married in April. Peter and Michael both live locally; when Rex retired from AAA, he partnered with Peter as local realtors. Rex hopes to pull Michael away from his own adventures to one day join him on his dream trip/pilgrimage of walking the Camino de Santiago across Spain.

Karen and Rex have served in several ministries at St. Therese. Rex has been active in a variety of men’s ministries while also serving as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion and as the lector coordinator for several years. He is also a member of the local secular community of the Discalced Carmelites. Karen and Rex eventually began to lead the baptism preparation program, working with the parish priests and deacons to educate parents and godparents about the sacrament of baptism for infants.

At the same time, they started their discernment of Rex’s call to enter permanent ministry, ultimately resulting in their being admitted to the Archdiocese’s Diaconate Formation Program. The formation process lasts five years, involving comprehensive theological education, spiritual formation, and pastoral training. While prayerfully discerning God’s call, they have been formed in the study of scripture, theology, and the teachings of the Church to deepen their understanding of the Faith and better serve the St. Therese community.

On June 8, Rex will be ordained to the Sacred Order of Permanent Deacon at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels in Los Angeles. Rex said, “We are eager to continue our journey of discipleship, embracing the call to serve God and His people with humility, love, and joy! We are filled with gratitude for the support and guidance we have received from the friars and the entire faith community at St Therese.”

Last November, Karen was diagnosed with breast cancer. Karen and Rex want to extend their deepest thanks and gratitude to all the members of the Parish who have been holding them up in prayer. Karen’s final chemotherapy treatment was May 22nd, and her prognosis is very good! The Owenses fully attribute this to God’s grace and the supportive prayers of this wonderful community!

"100th Jubilee Pilgrimage for St. Therese Parish"


TO VISIT ST. THERESE'S BASILICA IN FRANCE (& MORE!) for 12 days from October 3 to 14


