

## Lewistown District #97 ESSER Expenditures

Per ISBE, each school receiving ESSER funds must develop a plan for their use and submit the plan to ISBE within 90 days of the receipt of funds. School districts must also provide the public opportunity to provide input on the plan, take the input into account, and post the ESSER plan on the district website. Notice of the public hearing was posted in the Fulton County Democrat on August 3, 2021 for a public hearing to be held on August 18, 2021 at 6:15 p.m. in the District #97 board room.

### ESSER II Allocation—\$439,995

#### ESSER Expenditures

- Salaries for Reading Specialist teachers to address learning loss and provide service for at-risk students
- Summer School for students in K-11 at risk of not meeting grade level standards, including staff, materials, transportation and programs
- Remote learning teachers
- Reading series to address learning loss and the integration of online learning
- Site licenses for online intervention programs
- Equipment for provision of digital learning experiences, including Smart TV's for classrooms, updated computers, and studio production
- Increased Social Work services for students at all levels
- Professional development for teachers to address best practices for online learning

### ESSER III Allocation—\$1,035,431

#### ESSER Allocations

- Summer enrichment programs and activities to address learning loss, to include all staff, programs, materials, and transportation
- After-school tutoring for at-risk and special needs students
- Interventionist teacher at the elementary school
- Upgrade curriculum at all grade levels and curriculum areas to support online learning
- Increase SEL services for students at all grade levels
- Upgrade aging air conditioning units at the high school to improve air quality

As per grant requirements. At least \$20,709 must be allocated to address learning loss.
