THE OBLIGATION IS LIFTED

Per the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB),
because this feast falls on a Saturday,
the obligation to attend Mass is abrogated.



Canon Law 1248 §1 states:

*"A person who assists at a Mass
celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite
either on the feast day itself or in the
evening of the preceding day satisfies
the obligation of participating in the Mass."*

So, although the liturgy at the
5:00 p.m. Mass (celebrated by
Fr. Stephen) will be that of the
Assumption, it will still
**satisfy your obligation
to attend Sunday Mass.**
