Personal Items

In case of an emergency/accident, we ask that you send a change of clothes in a Ziploc bag that will be kept in your child's book bag. Please label the Ziploc bag with your child's name. If your child has an accident, we will send home that set of clothes to be washed, and we ask that you replace that set with a new one for your child's book bag. Please be sure to update this emergency bag as your child grows and the seasons change. We thank you in advance for your help with this!

Snack Time

Each day, we will have a snack time. This year, our snacks are being provided for our students through our District. You will not need to send in snacks for your child. Students will receive a healthy snack each day!

Money

All money that comes to school (PTA membership, school fees, field trips, yearbook, etc.) needs to be in an envelope/Ziploc bag clearly labeled with your child's name, the amount, and what the money is for. This will help us to make sure that the money gets to the right place quickly!

In addition to these units of study, we will also be including seasonal studies and author studies.

Assessments

Your child will be assessed this year using anecdotal records, teacher observations, checklists, and performance assessments to help document your child's progress. We also use a language and numeracy assessment called My IGDs. Over the course of the year, your child will be assessed on the following:

- Letter identification
- Knowledge of letter sounds
- Color and shape identification
- Number identification
- Counting objects
- Patterning
- Sorting/classifying
- Cutting skills
- Writing their name
- Rhyming words
