How to apply:

The following materials must be submitted to the Admissions Office no later than **January 27, 2023.**

- A type-written essay (one to two pages in length)
- Three letters of reference (at least one from high school instructor.)
- Application for admission to Lindsey Wilson College, high school transcript and ACT/SAT scores.
- Participation in interview on Scholars Day February 4, 2023.
