As a reminder, students must stay home if their fever is over 100.4 or if they are vomiting. Students who have stayed home due to illness may return to school when they have been without fever (without medication) for 24 hours and without diarrhea or vomiting for 48 hours. If students are taking an antibiotic, they may return to school after 24 hours.

Dress Code

- All bottoms must cover all skin above the mid-thigh, this includes dress, skirts, pants with holes and shorts.
