All you need to do is fill out a Google Form for each book that you read over the summer.




# What happens when we come back to school?

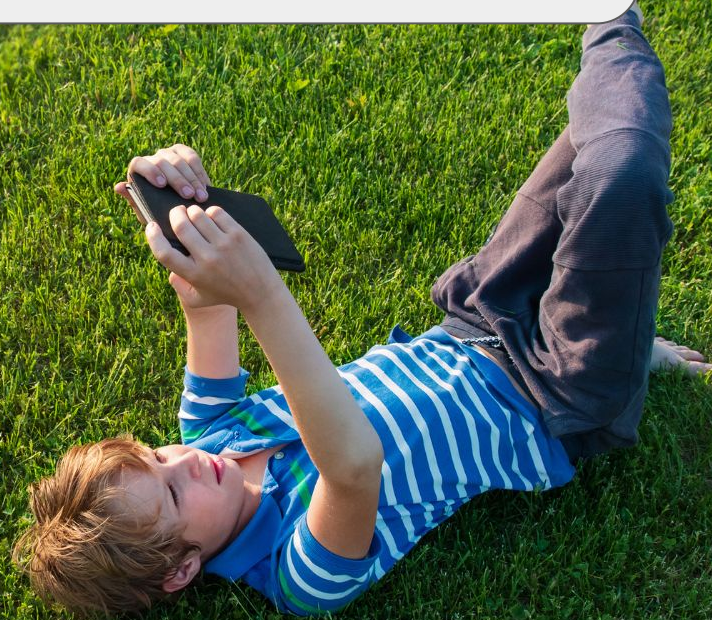
