## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

- Where do I apply? The web site for the FACTS Grant and Aid Company is https://online.factsmgt.com/aid
- Who can help me with my application? Each school has a financial aid campus coordinator who can answer any questions as you complete the application. If you have a question they can't answer, you may contact FACTS directly at 866-441-4637.
- Is there a cost to apply? There is a required \$40 application fee per family that is CHARGED BY the FACTS Company. ONE APPLICATION can include MULTIPLE STUDENTS and/or SCHOOLS.
- What paperwork do I need to complete the application? It is important to note that families will only be considered for financial aid if their application is VERIFIED by FACTS. In order to verify family income information, FACTS requires copies of financial documents including 2020 Federal Income tax forms and 2021 W-2s.
- When should I apply? The application process opens on December 13, 2021, and it is recommended that you apply early.
- Do I need to complete the application in one session? No, applications may be opened, saved and updated/completed at a later date. All supporting documents should be submitted as soon as possible before the final May 31st 3rd round deadline.
- Who do I contact if I have questions on my award? Awards are based upon the need assessment provided by FACTS and based on the financial inputs you provide in the system. Please work directly with your school campus coordinator if you have any questions about your award.
