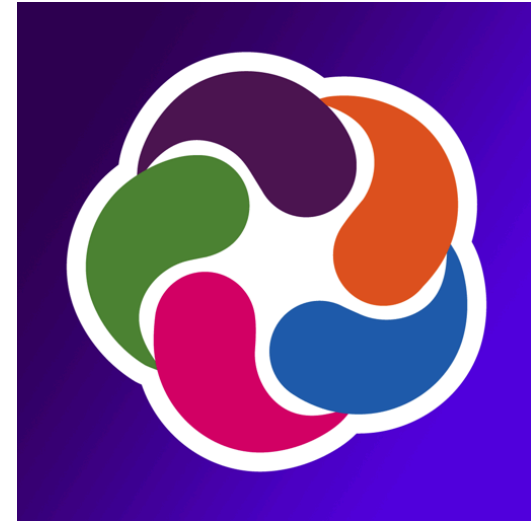

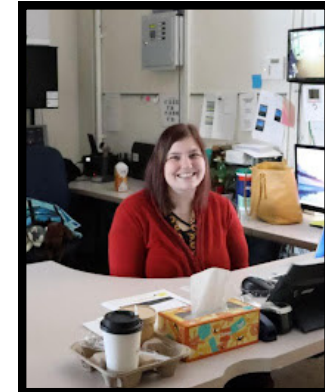

Developmental Kindergarten!

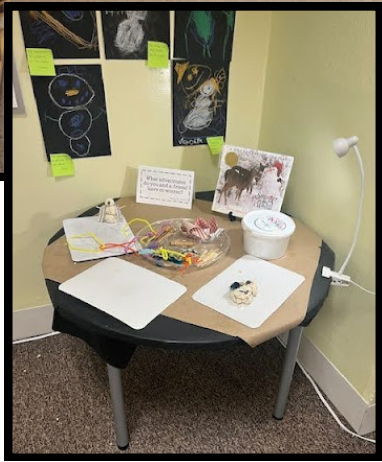
Back to School Tips

CAMP

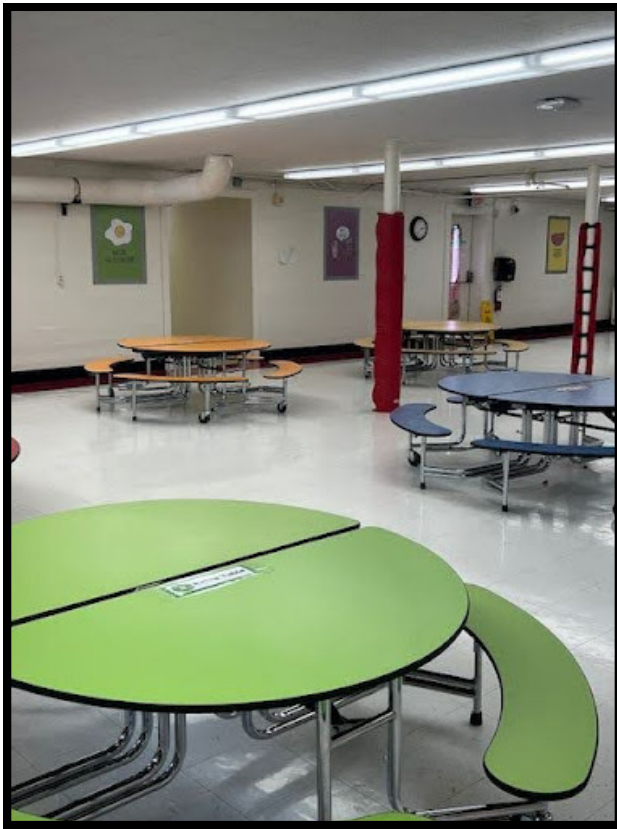
The first days of Developmental Kindergarten will be called DK Camp. This will be a chance for you to meet all the teachers, see all the classrooms, and meet new friends. When DK Camp is finished, you'll be assigned to a classroom where you'll spend the rest of the school year learning and having fun.



We have areas at our school for buses to drop off and pick up students. Parents may drop off and pick up students at the back entrance.



This is the school playground, where we learn social skills, teamwork, and build confidence.



Our school has a cafeteria where you will eat with your class. Adults will be available to help you during lunch. You can order a school lunch or bring your own lunch from home.
