Superintendent Report

Facility Projects

Work on the Main Entrance renovation has moved inside for the winter. The construction area has been enclosed with a temporary heavy plastic barrier for added safety and to prevent the spread of dust and debris.

The T-12 Library/lounge project is in the final design phase, Materials are being ordered and should begin arriving onsite in the next couple weeks.

New School Bus

A new school bus has been ordered from Hartley's. The bus is a newer version of our current 2020 route bus and will have all the bells and whistles. The purchase price was much more expensive than originally projected, \$164,500, but we have more than enough in our bus depreciation fund to cover the cost and have some reserves leftover. To offset a portion of the expense of the new bus, I intend to sell or trade-in our 2017 school bus. The new school bus is expected to arrive in late March of 2024,

Fire Extinguisher Cabinets

I am purchasing 6 new heavy-duty cabinets for our gym, weight room, and hallway fire extinguishers. These cabinets will be more secure and better protect our extinguishers from accidents. The cost of these cabinets is under \$2,000 and we will have to install them.
