OVERVIEW

Tanque Verde Unified School District is located in a residential community, 14 miles northeast of central Tucson. The district consists of two elementary schools, one junior high, and one high school. The high school ethnic profile reflects a student population of 68% White/Anglo, 24% Hispanic, 1% Asian/Pacific Islander, 1% Black/African-American, less than 1% American Indian, and 4% two or more ethnicities. Founded in 2005, Tanque Verde is a public, comprehensive high school. It currently serves approximately 775 students in grades 9-12. The Tanque Verde mascot is the Hawk, and the colors are green, black, and silver.

ACCREDITATION

TVHS is accredited through Cognia (formally AdvancED).

CURRICULUM

Tanque Verde has 180 school days per year, divided into two semesters. Students may take a maximum course load of 4.25 credits per semester. Tanque Verde offers a general comprehensive high school education as well as 23 Advanced Placement Courses, 3 dual enrollment courses, and 17 certifications in 15 levels of Career and Technical Education coursework.

Tanque Verde participates in the Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA) 3A South Division of schools including: volleyball, football, cross country, swimming, cheerleading, basketball, soccer, baseball, softball, golf, track, and tennis. **Extracurricular opportunities include:** Lit Club, Chemistry Club, Competitive Chess Team, Future Farmers of America (FFA), Math Club, Mock Trial, NHS, Pathfinder Club, Science Bowl, Skills USA, Student Council, Thespian Troupe, World Cultures Club, WISE, Yearbook, Robotics, and Marching Band.

Academic Recognition

Students are recognized for their weighted GPA. They can earn Cum Laude 3.9-4.0, Magna Cum Laude 4.01-4.249, and Summa Cum Laude 4.25+.

GPA WEIGHTING

Tanque Verde uses an A, B, C, D, F grading system with a common grading scale where A=90-100; B=80-89; C=70-79; D=60-69; and F=59 & below. Standard courses are weighted according to a 4.0 scale. Honors courses are weighted an additional .50 GPA points while Advanced Placement and Dual-Enrollment courses are weighted an additional 1.0 GPA points (Class of 2026).

Post High School Statistics

There were 152 graduates in the class of 2024. Of these students, 34% earned a 4.0+ weighted GPA and 43% earned a 3.0-3.99 weighted GPA. Additionally, 63% of the graduating class attended a 4-year college, 19% attended a 2-year college and 11% selected trade school, work or military service.
