2024-2025 ANNUAL VERIFICATION/RE-REGISTRATION

Attention ALL parents of current 7th and 8th grade students. Please complete your Online Registration/Annual Verification for the NEXT school year by **April 26th**. This process is for EVERY student returning to Thunderbolt or LHHS for the 2024-2025 school year. See below for start up instructions. You must have a ParentVue account in order to complete the process. If you need assistance, please contact our office. Please be sure to include your proof of Arizona residency as this must be updated each year. If you do not upload your proof, a hard copy must be provided and an Arizona Residency Documentation Form signed (available in our office). Residency documents may be emailed to susan.blanchard@lhusd.org, but the documentation form must still be signed. Bus riders must complete a new bus registration form for next year as well.

If you do not complete the online process, a paper packet will be required (available on request).

If your student will NOT be attending Thunderbolt or LHHS next year, please notify the office.




