## Perry High School Council Minutes

April 29, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stacy McDaniel at 7:03 a.m. in the Perry High School professional learning lab. Mr. Martin led the group in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

### New business included:

- Parent advisement was March 4-6. Parents met with advisors to set up fall schedules for their child. Mr. Martin asked if there were any concerns. Positive feedback was given by council members. Mr. Martin clarified a dual enrollment question for Ms. Oliver
- Drama department won Southeastern Theater Conference competition with their play, "Bookbinder." The group competed in Mobile, Alabama on March 15. Will receive championship rings for being first place in the nation
- Rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders visited the school on Friday, March 15. They toured the school with student tour guides. Parents attended Parent's Night on March 19 to learn about high school information. Dr. Cannon did an excellent job orchestrating this event.
- PHS hosted its 2<sup>nd</sup> Athletic Signing Day on April 10<sup>th</sup>. We had 6 athletes sign college scholarships to play at the collegiate level including Baseball, Golf, Football and Wrestling
- Prom was April 20<sup>th</sup> at the stadium gym. It was a beautiful event with great attendance.
- Sunday, April 28, we hosted the State Championship Ring Ceremony. Lunch was served in the gym and the ring ceremony was held in the auditorium.
- Tuesday, April 30, we will host the annual FFA Banquet. Both Perry High and Perry Middle will give out annual awards and scholarships. We are very proud of this program and its participants.

- Finals for students will be May 20, 21, and 22. Exemption letters will go out May 17.
