The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Sandra Mercier, Chair; Steve Stanley, Vice-Chair; Bobby Bearden; Terry Bramlett; and Lewis DeWeese. All members present.

Superintendent Mark Henson reviewed the agenda for the meeting on Thursday, August 9, 2012.

Mr. Henson shared results of the 2011 Sales Ratio Study with the Board. He explained Fannin's ratio was 33.86 percent, and the ratio should be at least 36 percent. With consideration to advice from School Board Attorney Lynn Doss, Mr. Henson said the Board should appeal this ratio. A motion was made by Terry Bramlett, seconded by Bobby Bearden, to appeal the 2011 Sales Ratio Study. All members voted yes; motion carried.
