Description	Inquiry is the model of instruction that lets students take ownership of their learning. Too often we let our own doubts hold our classrooms. During this day-long training, teachers will get to experience what it's like to be a student in an inquiry lesson, explore a simple model to construct lessons, examine tools and strategies to facilitate inquiry, and tackle actual planning with other educators. This is meant to change and adapt how we are instructing our students to help them reach more independence, creativity, and higher outcomes. For the teacher, the shift is away from an Arbiter of Knowledge to a Facilitator of Learning. This will be an interactive day to learn and collaborate together.
