ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT

It is the belief of the Board of Trustees that any student who is capable of, and wishes to do, college-level work while in high school should be permitted to do so and shall be given assistance in enrolling in advanced courses at area high schools, by the Principal of the North Country Charter Academy.

Any 11th- or 12th-grade student whose admission to a college-level course is recommended by the Principal may enroll in a course at an approved college for college credit, at no cost to the school. If the student wishes to receive high school credit for the course, he may request permission from the Principal, to apply the course toward high school graduation requirements.
