My father was a mixed African American who had Cherokee grandparents and my mother was African American. When I started school, I walked four miles to a segregated, one room facility. I became an outstanding math student at an early age. I developed an early interest in flying, but African Americans, Native Americans, and women had no flight training opportunities in the United States, so I saved and obtained sponsorships in Chicago to go to France for flight school. I was the first African-American woman and first Native American to hold a pilot license and was the first Black person to earn an international pilot's license. Who am I?
