The Pennsylvania Governor's School for the Sciences is a 5-week summer residential program for talented high school students of science and mathematics, which emphasized cooperative learning and hands-on laboratory research. Hosted by the Mellon College of Science at Carnegie Mellon University, the PGSS offers an enrichment experience in science, technology, engineering and mathematics. Applicant must be a current **junior** at the time of application and must be a resident of Pennsylvania, attending a public, charter, cyber or non-public secondary school. Successful applicants receive a full scholarship to the PGSS program, which includes housing, meals, and all instructional materials. Applications are due by January 31, 2024.
