# WMES School Improvement Council Meeting Thursday, February 23, 2023



The February School Improvement Council (SIC) Meeting was called to order at 4:35 P.M. by Mrs. Pandora, SIC Chair. # II. School Report/Building Update

- A. Presently our enrollment is 579 (increase from January's enrollment of 576). Kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade's enrollment stayed the same. The other grade level's fluctuated either by increasing or decreasing.
- B. The school will sponsor a Family Movie Night this Spring. A license has to be purchased, and the blow up screen has been delivered.
- C. Metal detectors have been delivered and will be installed at the front door and the 5<sup>th</sup> grade exit door. For now, they will be used for afterschool and parenting events.
- D. All DD4 students will have school ids. Elementary students' ids will be on bracelets that will be worn on the wrist. Ids will be worn to/from home.
  - 1. Questions—What is the replacement policy for the bracelets, if lost or destroyed? Will the ids have information embedded on them?
- E. Buses are still an issue in the afternoon, since four (4) buses have to double with the middle and high schools. The last bus leaves around 3:45 P.M.
