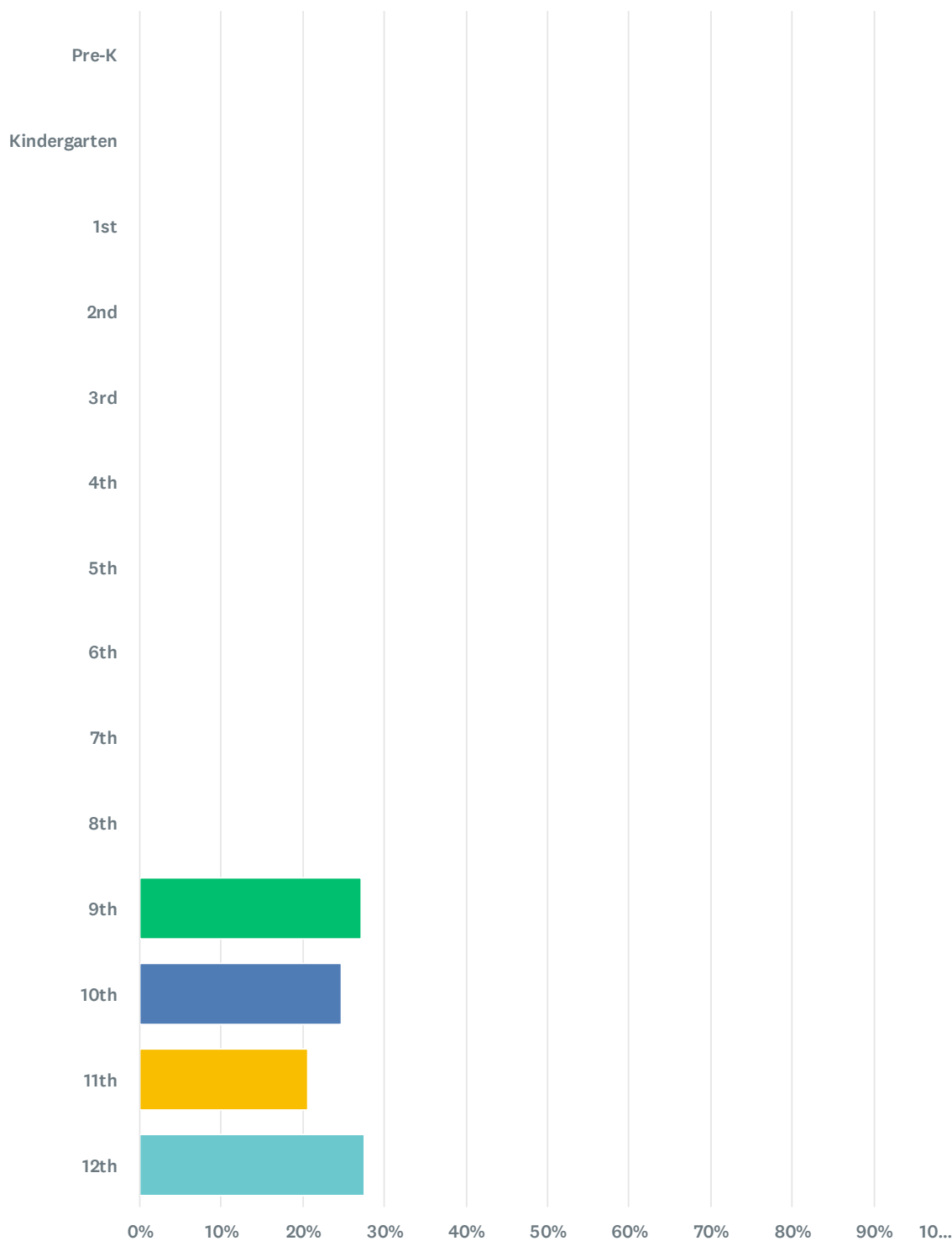

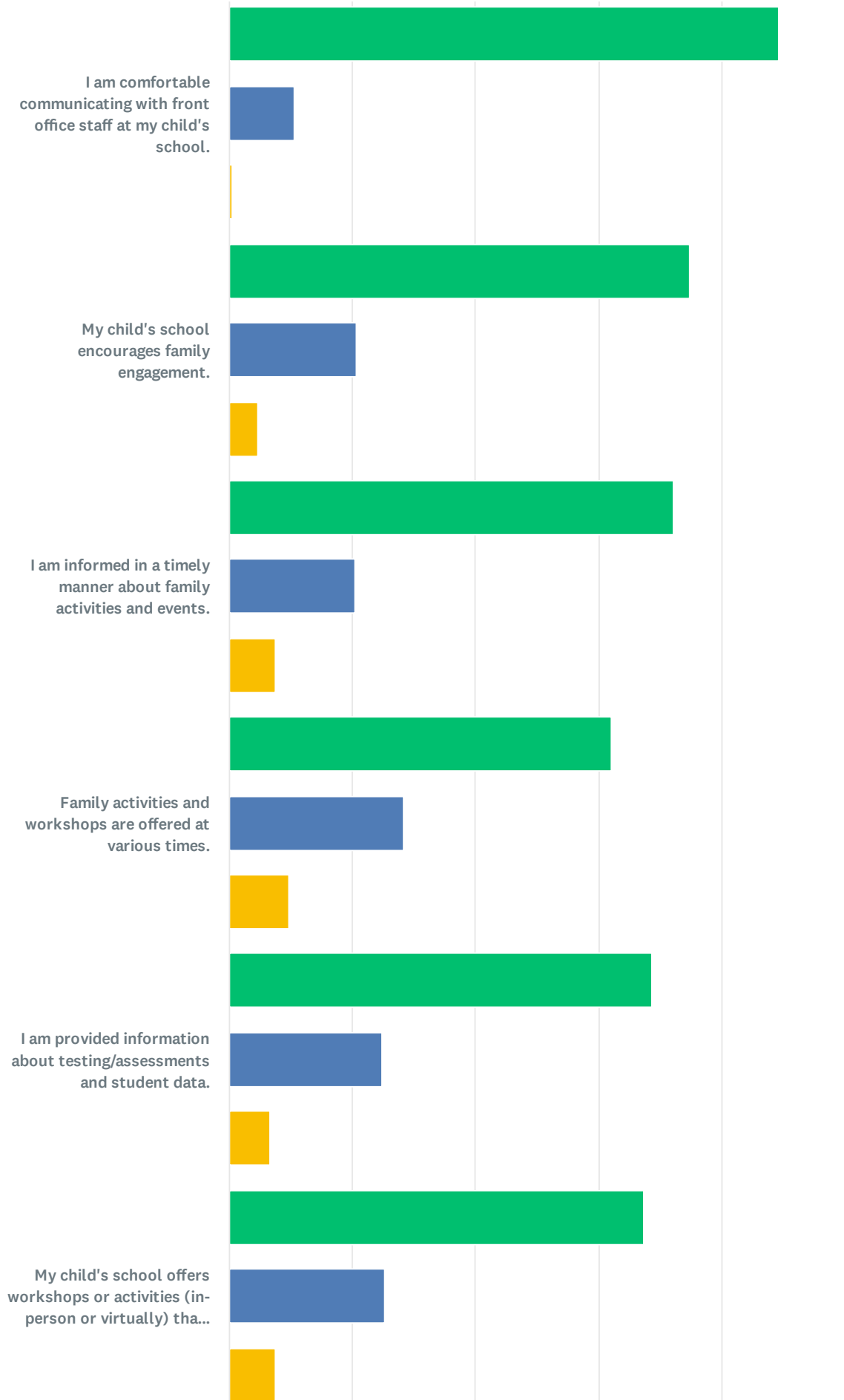

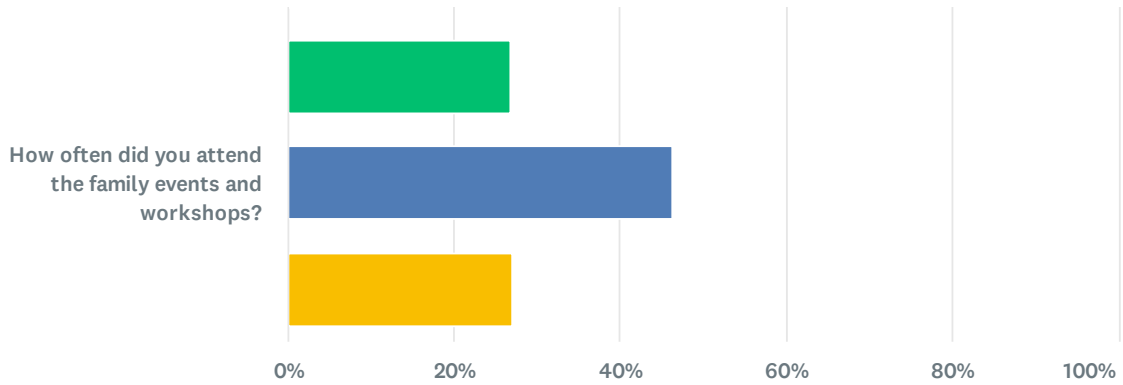

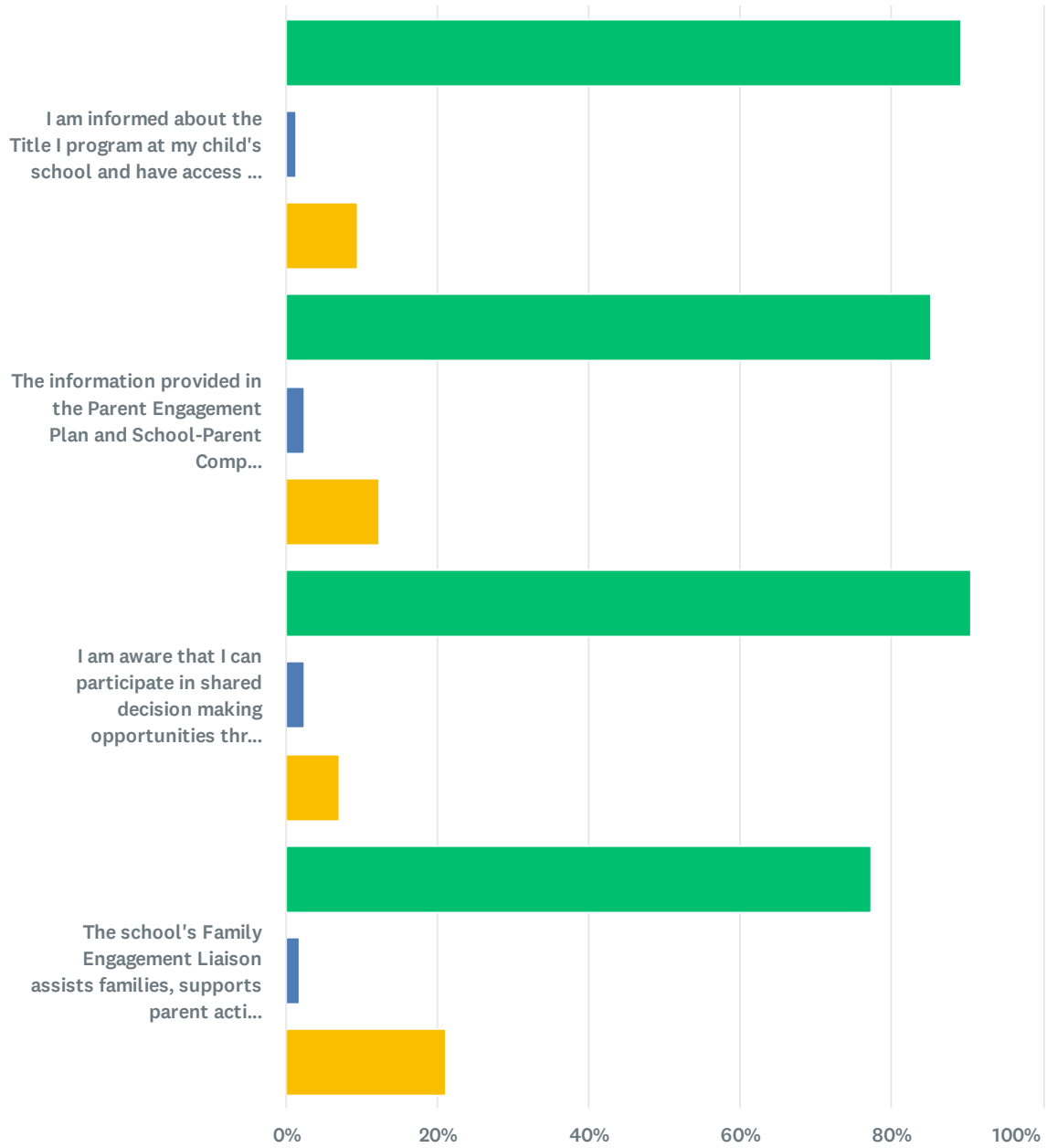

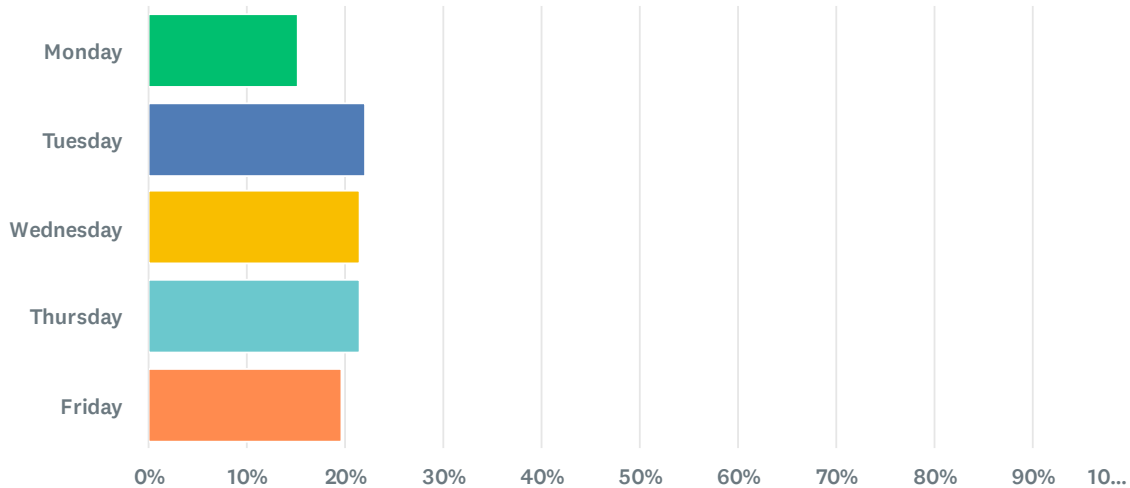

Q7 What day of the week do you prefer to attend academic-based school activities?

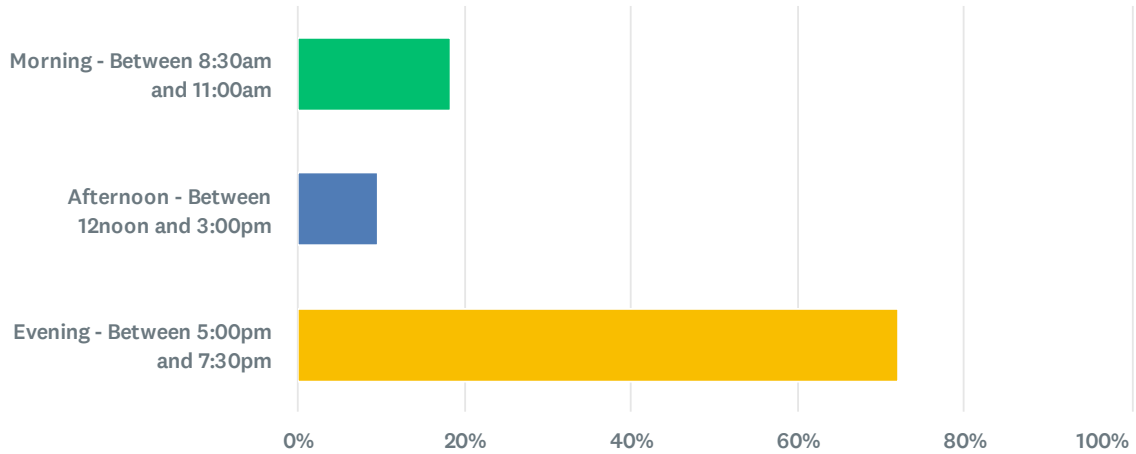

Q8 What is the best time for you to attend academic school activities/events? (Choose only one)

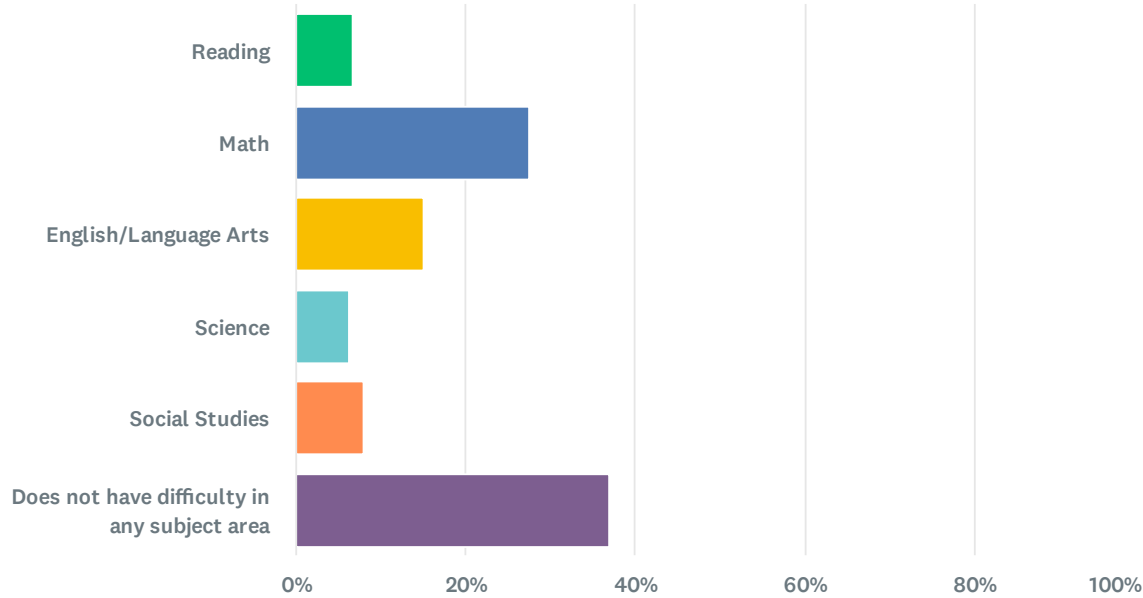
