Some highlights from the meeting are:

- * Scholastic Books for pre kindergarten through sixth grade will be purchased through the CJ Anderson Endowment in the amount of \$6,696. Each student will receive a book monthly from September through May.
- Plans were made for American Education Week in November.
- Tickets are on sale at various business places for the High Heels Quilt that was made and donated to us by Gloria Casey WHS 1947 graduate. They will also be available at the fall concert on October 18th. The drawing for the quilt will be at the elementary Christmas program on December 9th.
- A total of eleven letters have been sent to new staff members to welcome them to WAO and to inform them that they have \$200 to spend on things for their classroom/classes as a gift from the Foundation. They also have a \$50 gift

certificate from the WAO Wearhouse to purchase Pony clothing. In addition one \$100 letter was sent to a new part-time staff member.
