1. **brook**: a small stream
2. **plowed**: turned over and cut through out
3. **settler**: a person who comes to live in a new land or country
4. **mist**: a cloud of tiny drops of water or other liquid that is in the air
5. **sheets**: a thin, broad piece or surface of something
6. **haze**: mist, smoke, or dust in the air
7. **grazed**: to feed on growing grass
8. **skimmed**: to move over lightly and swiftly
9. **blurry**: dim or hard to see; unclear
10. **pulsed**: to beat or vibrate
