B.H.S. FACES THE WAR IN THE GULF

On August 2, 1990, Saddam Hussein of Iraq invaded the nation of Kuwait by sending 100,000 of his troops into this tiny Middle Eastern country. With this move, Hussein disrupted the lives of many people, including those of B.H.S. students, faculty, and staff.

Tension was high as school began as a total of twenty-eight nations came together in Operation Desert Shield. U.S. troops were deployed to the Saudi Arabian desert. Among these troops were parents, husbands, sons, relatives, and friends of people associated with B.H.S. Tension grew and then accelerated as the United Nations Security Council gave Hussein until January 15, 1991, to unconditionally withdraw from Kuwait, and that deadline passed without compliance from Iraq's leader.

On January 16, 1991, nineteen hours after the deadline, massive attacks began on Iraq and occupied Kuwait. Televisions in the classrooms were tuned in to get the latest news on what was now termed Operation Desert Storm. Everyone became acquainted with terms such as Scud missiles, chemical warfare, Patriot missiles, smart bombs, Apache helicopters, and A-10's. Everywhere were American flags and yellow ribbons as those at home supported the troops and anxiously awaited their safe return.

On February 2, 1991, Iraqi troops set fire to more than 600 Kuwaiti oil wells, and the air attack continued. While the war from the air was going well for the 28 nation coalition, everyone dreaded a ground war because of reports of Hussein's weaponry. But on February 23, 1991 the ground war attack did begin, and the world held its breath. But, much to everyone's amazement, most Iraqis did not fight, but joyously surrendered. They had been without adequate food and water. Exactly 100 hours after the beginning of the ground war assault, President Bush ordered a cease-fire order, and Kuwaiti Government Officials declared Kuwait liberated.

The United States lost 292 troops and 27 planes. Then the task of rebuilding Kuwait, extinguishing the oil fires, and bringing our troops and equipment home began, and continues as the school year closes. U.S. troops have returned to parades and welcoming parties.

Although most Americans loathe Saddam Hussein, in a most unexpected way, he renewed our patriotism and our pride in our great nation. The American spirit has been rejuvenated!

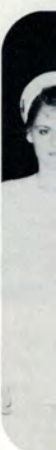
