NOTIFICATION OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE ON CAMPUS

Dear North Zulch ISD Parents, Guardians, Faculty and Staff,

In keeping with North Zulch ISD's practices to respond to COVID-19, we are notifying all student families that 1 staff member and 1 secondary student were test-confirmed to have COVID-19.

Due to privacy requirements, we will not be releasing the name of the individual or details that may identify him or her. North Zulch ISD will post letters daily to the district website to inform parents of any new test-confirmed cases. NZISD will also begin posting a weekly spreadsheet on the website under the COVID tab that lists the total active cases and overall total cases, year to date. This will be done each Monday.

In the interest of health and safety, we encourage staff, students, and families to monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19. Screening includes consideration about whether an individual has recently begun experiencing any of the following in a way that is not normal for them.

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0° F
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting

If you or any member of our North Zulch ISD community does begin experiencing any of these symptoms in a way that is not typical, we encourage you to contact your physician. We encourage anyone in the North Zulch ISD community who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19 to please notify our school by contacting Casey Lucherk at 936-241-7105.
