Secondary News

Semester 1 has ended and we are on to the 2nd.

- As we go into the new semester, please remember that students may earn exemption from taking final exams in each class based on a combination of their overall grade and a percentage of completed assignments. This is a change from previous years when attendance factored into it. Below is a reminder of how this works...
 - Students who have maintained the following grades and work completion rates in a semester may be exempt from final exams as follows:
 - A student who has maintained a 90% or above average and has an 85% competition rate for classwork.
 - A student who has maintained an 80%- 89% average and has a 90% completion rate for classwork.
 - A student who has maintained a 75%- 79% average and has a 100% completion rate for classwork.
 - Students may not fail a class in either quarter and be exempt from the semester final for that class.

Latah County Community Foundation, Literacy Grant

• The Deary School Library was just awarded a \$3,000 grant through the Latah County Community Foundation. The main focus of this grant is to expand the school library collection and to enhance our school library program through the addition of school library-based reading incentives to help foster literacy among students. Possible incentives tied to this funding include library visit punch cards, library scavenger hunts, and reading awards for most books read.
