Introduction:

This training is to provide basic knowledge on suicide, the three levels of engagement and to support the Local Education Agency's policy on suicide prevention. The script will be read during the presentation to create video segments. *Question Worksheets*– Each question should appear one at a time with the answer options. If the individual selects the wrong answer, the correct answer will be shared. If the individual selects the correct answer, they should hear or see something indicating they are correct. Once all individuals have seen the correct answer, the additional fact for that question/answer should appear. Then to the next question and so forth.
