Maghan Hunt: I was alarmed when a former staff member told me about posting the board agenda and how the Board has been filled. A letter was sent to the Board to read in public comment by a community member whose child is enriled: Was recently informed by the Principal and

other staff members about my child being punished and making my daughter walk "correctly" without knowledge of her physical ability. This is unacceptable and could have caused my child harm. I am normally happy with the school system and now that Lillian Gonzalez has been here, there has been much harm done to students by her.

Nick Chandler: We are a part of the Booster's Club and have many children here. We do not want the Booster Club to be shut down.
