The Trion Board of Education met in the regular monthly meeting on Monday, January 10, 2022. The meeting was held in the Board Room of the Board of Education office located at 239 Simmons Street, Trion, Georgia.

Present for the meeting were: Dr. Phil Williams, Superintendent, Vice Chair Kari Brown, Members Johnny Brimer, and Darriel Broome. Also in attendance were Howard Hughes, Jason Lanham, Gene Espy, and Mandy Taylor.

New Business

- The board received and approved the SPLOST and General Fund Obligation Bonds financial reports.
- The system financial reports were submitted and approved by the board members.
- The tuition for 2022/2023 school was set at \$150 for out of district students with a \$450 maximum per family. The Town of Trion employees will be exempted from tuition fees.

Other Business

The board received the Bulldog Athletic Club and Band Booster financial reports as information items. The BAC reports \$ 68,425.78 as the closing balance. The band booster club reports a balance of \$ 16,587.24 with \$2,829.10 in savings.

Student Enrollment report was submitted as an information item. As of January 5, 2022, the student population is reported at 1,352 with breakdown as follows: TES - 678; TMS - 293; THS – 381.
