#### **CTE Classes Are Awarded Grants**

Our Career and Technical Education (CTE) classes were recently awarded grants for updating and purchasing new equipment for their programs. Our woodshop teacher Mr. Kepler won a state grant for \$75,000 from OSPI, and the Business & IT teacher Mrs. Schimelpfenig received over \$88,000 for new Chromebooks, computer lab systems, and computer software programs to meet state and industry standards. 


#### Track & Field



### **Facilities Update**



#### **Modernization Project**

We had our first meeting with Aetta, the architects chosen for the modernization project. The first phase Aetta will conduct is the Educational Specification process. This is the process of defining and communicating the District's goals and requirements for what the facility should incorporate to accommodate their program. The specifications include a look at all areas of the building, all academic and extracurricular activities, and how they work together in planning the modernization.

This process includes meeting with a variety of representative groups for input about the design of the school modernization. Two of these groups are our parents and the public. One way to give input will be via a survey conducted electronically. Additionally, Aetta Architects will be at our April school board meeting to take input from the public and school board. That meeting will take place on April 18 at 5:30 pm in the Library.

#### **Concession Stand**

We have held our introductory meeting with the selected contractor. Next, a planning meeting will occur the last week of March. The construction phase is to begin in April, with anticipated completion in August.

#### The Bond

The process of preparing for the issuance of the \$1.9 million approved by voters in the February election has begun. The plan will start with preparing all the required documentation to sell tax-exempt, municipal bonds to investors across the country. We expect to begin the documentation process in early June, culminating in a bond sale in mid-August and closing of the issue in early September.
