 - The Safe Return to In-Person Learning plan has been modified based on CDC guidelines and been submitted to the state department for approval.
 - Online registration is currently open using our on-line Power School portal. Schools
 will have an open registration day for those needing assistance on July 19 and 20
 during regular business hours.
 - The initial three-year, county-wide contract for Adult Education ends on June 30, 2022, and a proposed five-year agreement from Dr. O'Malley is included in the For Action Agenda for board approval.
 - The district has been approved for an additional 4K class, if student enrollment reaches 45, which is presently at 39.
